General Information

Academic Requirements	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. To be enrolled as a regular student at home university. 2. Meet the required GPA by home university.
Academic Requirements	Certificate of B1 level of Spanish as a minimum, according to the Common European Framework.
Program Duration	One (1) semester, which may be extended to one (1) additional semester. (Maximum 1 year).
Academic Information	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The internship program and thesis courses are not covered in the exchange program. 2. The Javeriana grading scale is from 0,0 to 5,0. 5,0 being the highest score and 3,0 the passing grade. 3. Full time study corresponds to an average of 17-20 academic credits per semester. 4. An academic credit is equivalent to a total of 48 hours of academic work. 5. Exchange students whose first language is not Spanish are advised to take between 10 and 12 credits per semester.

Application Process

Application Documents	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Official presentation letter issued by Home university. 2. Certificate of academic course grades (transcript of records) issued by Home University. 3. Motivation letter stating the reasons why you want to study at Pontificia Universidad Javeriana. 4. Certificate of Spanish language proficiency (level B1) for students whose first language is not Spanish. 5. Copy of valid passport
Application Dates	<p>August 1st to October 14th 2019: for studies in the first half of 2020 (January – June).</p> <p>February 3rd to April 17th 2020: for studies in the second half of 2020 (July – November)</p> <p>August 1st to October 12th 2020: for studies in the first half of 2021 (January – June).</p>
Learning Agreement	<p>Students may consult the provisional list of subjects via the following link: Academic courses</p> <p>They can also take a look at the English Taught Course Guide.</p> <p>Note: The learning agreement is subject to approval by each Program Director at Javeriana and the availability of places for each course.</p>

Documents for enrolment

Visa	The candidate must contact or visit the nearest Colombian embassy/consulate to find out the type of permission required for the exchange. If the student's exchange will last for a year, they must request a one-year acceptance letter.
International Medical Insurance	The student must have, for the whole length of stay, an international traveling insurance (health/accidents) when they arrive in Colombia, with international coverage and with repatriation in case of death.

Accommodation	The university does not have student accommodation, but it does provide advice for finding accommodation in the city.
