The University of Queensland Short-Term Study Travel Grants

The University of Queensland Short-Term Study Travel Grants are provided to assist qualified students of the University to undertake a period of study overseas

1. UQ Abroad may award travel grants twice each year;
2. The value of each grant is \$1000;
3. The grants are open to students who:
 - (a) are undertaking a degree program ('the UQ program) of this University;
 - (b) are participating in a short-term program **for-credit** or **for-formal-recognition** as approved by UQ Abroad;
 - (c) have met all the required eligibility criteria as determined by UQ Abroad;
 - (d) have received pre-approval of credit-transfer from their UQ Faculty;
 - (e) have received formal acceptance from their host for participation in the program.
4. The allocation of grants is determined by a selection committee, taking into consideration the following:
 - (a) financial hardship (as defined by UQ);
 - (b) academic merit (cumulative GPA on the student UQ Studies Report at the time of application);
 - (c) academic progression at the time of application.
5. The University endeavours to support as many different students as possible to engage with a range of global opportunities and allocates funding accordingly. If a student has already received funding, and subsequently applies for further support, the selection committee will take into consideration financial need and equity of applicants;
6. Students can receive a maximum of one Short-Term Study Travel Grant throughout their studies at UQ.
