Course Requirements	Please note that for most courses there are special eligibility requirements which are determined by the departments. Application to exchange program does not guarantee any course registration. Law students need to have studied at least 120 credits of law or related areas in order to take law courses. 120 credits is equivalent to two years of full time studies. <b>Courses offered by the Stockholm Business School and the Department of Law are very popular. Students should be flexible in their course selection.</b> Please also bear in mind that the Stockholm Business School can only confirm any admittance to their courses about a week before the semester starts.
Swedish Language Course	Swedish language courses, on different levels, are offered for free by the Department of Swedish Language and Multilingualism to all incoming exchange students <u>su.se/studyswedish</u> . Information about the language courses is available on the link provided.
