Application Procedure

Talk to your study abroad advisor about studying on exchange at UMass Amherst. Once you are nominated by your study abroad office, you will be sent an email with the online application. All application materials must be submitted through the application portal. All required documents should be prepared in PDF format before starting the application as you will not be able to save your progress. The completed online application and the PDF documents must be submitted at the same time. See below for more information.

Application Requirements

You will need the following documents to submit your application:

- Official Transcript(s): Including all completed courses as well as a list of your current courses.
- Letter of Recommendation: One letter of recommendation from an academic source.
- Financial Documentation: Current bank statement(s) from student, financial sponsor (with financial sponsor letter) or both. Bank statements must be dated within the last 6 months.
- English Language Proficiency (Required for non-English speakers): The minimum scores are 550 for the paper-based TOEFL test, 80 for the computer-based TOEFL test, and 6.5 for the IELTS.

EXPENSES & FEES



ALL EXCHANGES COVER THE COST OF TUITION AND FEES. MOST OFTEN, STUDENTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ROOM, BOARD, HEALTH INSURANCE, AND PERSONAL EXPENSES.

ALL OF THE FOLLOWING COSTS ARE ESTIMATED PER SEMESTER.

COVERED COSTS:

For your exchange with the UMass Amherst, all costs associated with university tuition and fees will be covered. These expenses are paid by the UMass International Programs Office, per our agreement with your home institution, and will appear as a payment on your Bursar bill.*

Tuition, Registration, Curriculum Fees: \$8,200.00

Total Paid By UMass: \$8,200.00

*Some exchange agreements may also cover some of the costs below.

STUDENT COSTS:

You are responsible to pay for these items:

Room Fees: \$3,431.00

Dining Services: \$2,978.00

Health Insurance: \$772.50

Miscellaneous: \$1,700.00

Final Cost to Student: \$8,881.50*

*This amount may vary based on the specific exchange agreement.

Note: All student costs are based on previous year pricing. All cost will increase up to 10%. Additionally, student may upgrade or change housing and dining plans. Health insurance is mandatory and cannot be waived.
