Programmes

Study Abroad

Students coming from a non-partner institution will need to apply for our study abroad programme. Students may select modules from any area as long as the module is available for that semester, the student meets all eligibility criteria (including pre-requisites), and there are no faculty restrictions. [Tuition fees](#) are payable to Queen Mary University of London.

Exchange

If Queen Mary University of London has an exchange partnership agreement with an overseas institution (European Exchange, International Exchange (IEP) and Swiss-European Mobility (SEMP) programmes), students will first need to be nominated to study abroad at Queen Mary University of London by their home institution before applying to study abroad on exchange with us. Sending institutions can nominate their exchange students by sending an email to study-abroad@qmul.ac.uk. They should then direct their nominated exchange students [to apply online](#).
