Nomination Deadlines for Incoming Students	For the following winter semester: 1 May For the following summer semester: 1 October Please note that the database will close after the deadline of 1 May and reopen on 15 July.		
Nomination Requirements	Min. age: 18 years. Min. 2 semesters completed at the home institution before exchange.		
Application	Online application (application details will be sent to the nominated students directly). The necessary personal information may be forwarded to the Austrian Federal Ministry for Europe, Integration and Foreign Affairs (BMEIA) in order to support the student's application for a visa/residence permit.		
Language Requirements	CEFR B2 or equivalent in the language of instruction. Please note that in many study fields most of the courses are taught in German. For students studying German Studies at the University of Vienna the new required level of German is CEFR C1.
