


Fact Sheet for the University-wide Student Exchange Program

USTEP Overview

UTokyo accepts exchange students from partner universities with a Memorandum of Understanding concerning student exchange. Exchange students can choose between Type U (for undergraduate students) and Type G (for graduate students) programs.

UTokyo, as outlined below, after their acceptance is confirmed.

One semester: JPY 720,000 / Full Year: JPY 1,440,000

- 1. Prospective applicants must contact the office responsible for student exchange at their home university and check the application requirements and procedures for the exchange program to study at UTokyo.
- 2. Applicants nominated by their home universities will be provided the application instructions including the link to access an online application form.
