

Bocconi in 1902


Milano Piazza Duomo - 1900



# Bocconi Sport Center

The **Bocconi Sport Center** is part of the most recent expansion of the Bocconi Urban Campus. It includes a large green area and buildings at the forefront in terms of environmental sustainability.

**Bocconi Sport Center** includes a water sports facility, with a 50m **Olympic swimming pool** and a 25m training pool, a **fitness area**, an elevated **running track** and the Bocconi **Sport Arena**, a multifunctional facility for practicing team sports like basketball, volleyball and five-a-side football.









# Bocconi Health & Safety

Bocconi University manages on-campus services and activities in compliance with the indications of local and national authorities. Bocconi has obtained the **Biosafety Trust Certification**: the first certification system created to provide a set of benchmark best practices to minimize the risk of spreading epidemics in public and private gathering places.

The University is doing its best to guarantee the highest level of safety on campus:

- ✓ Ambulance with 2 paramedics present on campus Monday through Friday
- ✓ Permanent on campus medical center: a first-level internal medicine service for the Bocconi community. An infirmary is active on campus Monday through Friday
- ✓ Bocconi Emergency Number: to report all emergencies on campus
- ✓ Control Room: to monitor the campus video surveillance system real time
- ✓ **SOS Stations**: 4 columns in the external areas of the campus connected to the Control Room
- ✓ Campus Security Service: operators perform a patrol service on campus
- ✓ Walking Companion Service: to and from the university residences located off campus



# Diversity, Equity and Inclusion

Bocconi is committed in fostering social mobility, inclusivity, diversity and sustainability for students, faculty, staff and visitors.

The Dean for Diversity and Inclusion is a core anchor for advancing a culture of equal opportunities. - A dedicated team available to support all incoming exchange students in better adjusting to their new lives in Italy, in Milan and at Bocconi





### Services and Activities

The ISD offers exchange students a series of tailored services and activities to help them acclimate to their new surroundings during the beginning of their program and support them throughout their stay

#### Orientation and relocation program

A series of meetings organized at the beginning of each semester

#### Welcome activities

The ISD office organizes a series of social events and orientation activities at the beginning of each semester to help students feel at home

#### Housing

The central Bocconi Housing Office is in charge of managing all housing-related matters for incoming exchange students, including the online housing application

#### Italian language courses

Designed to help exchange students get familiar with Italian

### Academic advising

Professors available to guide exchange students through their course selection

#### International SOS

Medical, safety and security advice and assistance 24/7 for incoming students



### Italian Language Courses

The International Student Desk organizes optional extra-curricular **Italian language courses** to help exchange students get familiar with Italian:

### **Italian Language in-person Crash Course**

Period: before the beginning of Bocconi classes

Levels: from beginner up to advanced

Workload: 40 hours

Fee: 250 €

Attendance: mandatory

### **Italian Language in-person Follow-Up Course**

Period: during the semester

Levels: from pre-elementary up to intermediate

Workload: 30 hours

Fee: 200 €

Attendance: mandatory





### **Academic Info**

**Over 200 courses** taught in **English** available each semester for incoming exchange students



#### **Course Selection:**

Students select their classes online prior to the beginning of the semester. They will also have the chance to modify their study plan after attending the first days of classes (Add/Drop period)

### **Academic Advising:**

3 Professors (Business & Management, Economics, Law) are available to help incoming students build their study plan and assist them with any academic related matters.

#### **Study plan guidelines:**

- ✓ Min. 1 max. 5 courses per semester
- Undergraduate students can choose only undergraduate courses
- ✓ Language courses cannot be included in the study plan
- Bocconi Credit System is ECTS equivalent (1 Bocconi credit corresponds to a 25-hour workload, of which 8 lecture hours)



### International SOS

Bocconi has partnered with **International SOS**, the world's leading medical & travel security assistance company, to provide **medical**, **safety** and **security advice** and assistance to travelling students worldwide 24/7.

Services are designed to help with medical, travel and security problems that may arise when away from home and they are dedicated to students participating in International Programs offered by Bocconi University as well as **incoming exchange students** travelling to Bocconi from partner universities.

International SOS is not an insurance and does not replace a personal medical insurance or any other insurance students may have.

#### International SOS **services** include:

- **✓ Before Leaving:** *Information about the country of destination*
- ✓ While Abroad: Advice on health and security issues
- ✓ **In Case of Emergency:** Assistance in case of medical or security emergency
