The Indian Institute of Technology Delhi (IITD), recognized as an "Institute of Eminence" by the Government of India, is one of the top higher education institutions in the world. Located in the national capital and spread across 350 acres, IITD boasts state-of-the-art research facilities and offers a vibrant campus life with a strong focus on both academic and extracurricular development.

The UQ-IITD Research Academy (<https://uqiitd.org/>), a joint initiative between The University of Queensland (UQ) and IITD, promotes impactful and transnational research by leveraging the expertise and infrastructure of both leading institutions. Currently, the Academy hosts more than 120 joint PhD students across a wide range of disciplines.

This program is open to currently enrolled UQ HDR students from all disciplines, including Science, Technology, Engineering, Health, Business, Humanities, and Social Sciences. A total of ten positions are available. Selected students will be offered two weeks of accommodation and meals on the IITD campus.

- Open to currently enrolled HDR students at the University of Queensland.
- Students enrolled in the UQ-IITD Joint HDR program are not eligible.
- Students from all disciplines are encouraged to apply.

Application Requirements:

- ▶ Receive a letter of consent from a host faculty member at [IIT Delhi](#). Applicants are required to contact the host faculty directly.
- ▶ Completed and signed HDR Student Travel Declaration form, found on the [UQ Student Travel Procedure](#).
- ▶ Receive a letter of recommendation from the applicant's thesis supervisor at UQ
- ▶ A one-page statement of purpose outlining your interest in the program and academic goals.
- ▶ A current two-page CV
- ▶ Completed the Global Enrichment Experiences application (linked below) and include all documents listed above.
