# Keynote abstract

Join Janine Rix, Kelly Hooper and Tania Brooks for a keynote presentation. Their SSP project aimed to understand psychosocial hazards experienced by students in Nursing, Midwifery, and Social Work (NMSW) during practical and clinical placements, including mapping current educational and support mechanisms.

While initial expectations focused on common hazards such as bullying, violence, and sexual harassment, the findings revealed unexpected insights into broader psychosocial risks impacting student wellbeing. By exploring students' lived experiences, the project highlights the need for more nuanced and responsive support systems. The next phase involves co-designing strategies and structures to improve controls, foster psychosocial safety, and empower students to thrive both professionally and personally.

#### Dr Janine Rix (she/her)

Janine is a Student Experience Coordinator in the Faculty of Health, Medicine and Behavioural Sciences (HMBS) who has 20+ years of experience working in student learning, support, transition and retention roles at multiple higher education institutions. In 2025, she participated in her fourth Student-Staff Partnership project, and values the invaluable authentic student voice that is highlighted through these projects.

#### **Kelly Hooper**

Kelly is a Clinical Lecturer at the School of Nursing, Midwifery and Social Work and the Academic Lead for Student Engagement, Experience and Employability.
