School of Management, Fudan University (FDSM) is a leading business school in China. Structured at an international level, the School has 8 departments with around 150 full-time faculty members from all major business areas. A long history of business teaching has nurtured current multilevel system of education at the School. Always being one of the first providers in Mainland China of its kind, the School currently provides high-quality business education spanning science degree programs at Bachelor, Master and PhD levels, professional degree programs of MBA/ EMBA and MPACC, and post-doctoral research.

FDSM's linkage with top world universities ranges from countries and regions such as US, Canada, UK, Germany, France, Norway, Italy, Japan, Singapore, Hong Kong, Taiwan, etc. Memberships of organizations, such as AACSB, EFMD, PIM, GMAC, etc., help the School further boost its global influence and eventually give students the benefit of broader international exposure. The School has attained the two leading business school accreditations – EQUIS and AACSB in 2009 and 2010, respectively. This is a milestone on the School's pathway to build a top-tier business school in the world, and creates a stage for its future development. In 2012, the School became the first business school of Mainland Chinese universities being granted a five-year accreditation by EQUIS. In 2014, the School is the only Chinese business school that has 4 programs listed in the Financial Times Executive MBA Ranking.

International Exchange Programs at the School

The School offers international exchange programs at Bachelor, MBA and PhD levels, and has built student exchange partnerships with over 70 prestigious business schools around the world. Each year, the School accepts more than 100 exchange students from overseas partner schools and sends the similar number of Fudan students abroad. Our international exchange programs provide a unique learning environment for incoming exchange students to understand Chinese business, culture and society. In addition to English taught courses in a wide range of subjects from business, humanities to sciences, incoming students can join a variety of extracurricular activities including orientation, workshop, company visits, forums and lectures, gaining wider and more in-depth learning as well as enjoying a colorful and pleasant life at Fudan and in China.

Extracurricular Activities for International Exchange Students

Students Orientation is a fun and activity-packed event provided to incoming students at the first week of each academic year. It introduces incoming students to all aspects of the School and the Exchange Program, and gets the students off to the best possible start at Fudan.

“Learning and Living in China” Workshop offers a special one-day off-campus environment for incoming students to interact with each other and with representatives from the University and the School. It is held in the first month of Spring semester, aiming to help incoming student get to know each other and better prepare for their study at Fudan and living in China.

“Experiencing China Business” Company Mobile Class provides a particular learning experience for incoming students by combining a visit to 2-3 characteristic Chinese companies with a mobile class on the topics related to the company visit. The successful visits of Alibaba Group, Zhejiang Guangbo Group, Shanghai Laiyifen Co. Ltd., Yiwu International Trade Mart in 2014, 2013, 2012 and 2011 allowed the students to gain a better understanding of business environment and managerial practices in China, which enriched their learning experience during the exchange studies at Fudan.

Series of Forums and Lectures are important components of campus life for all students of the School, including international exchange students. For example, “Humanity Fudan” series of seminars enlighten the mind by discussing a wide range of topics, “Forum of Management Masters” and “Fudan Aegon-Industrial Master Forum” broaden the horizon with elites from various societal sectors.

Language of Instruction	All courses offered to exchange students are conducted entirely in English.																													
CourseSelection	Exchange students have the freedom in course selection via the Fudan online course registration system provided they meet the course prerequisites on a space available basis. Courses registration for exchange students starts on the first day of class. Since the English taught course list is not available online, exchange students may contact program coordinator for the information within one month prior to the beginning of semester.	The most up-to-date course information will be issued two months prior to the new semester and students will be informed of the course selection information after nomination.																												
Workload	Each credit point corresponds to 18 contact hours per semester. For example, a two-credit subject equal 36 hours per semester, a 3-credit subject equals 54 hours. Exchange students may study a maximum of 6 courses; a minimum of 2 courses is required for exchange students to maintain visa status.
