THINGS TO KNOW ABOUT THE CAMPUS

Teaching Rooms and Open Spaces

Basic rules of cleanliness and discretion must be observed at all times.

At times, part of the campus may be allocated to specific programs. During such periods, students from other programs will not be allowed to use those open areas reserved for break-out sessions.

Bookings of facilities & videoconferencing

- Booking requests have to be sent to bookings.apac@essec.edu at least 5 working days in advance.
- Indicate name of requester, program you are attending, reason for booking, date and time.
- Bookings are normally considered for 9am to 6pm on normal working days.
- After-office hours and non-working days will be considered case-by case basis.
- Please call 59700 during Saturdays (this can be dialed using the phone inside the break-out room) to ask for switching on the air-con in the break out rooms)
- The breakouts rooms on level 4 (1, 3, 4 & 5) are opened and do not require any booking on weekdays from 8 am to 8pm.

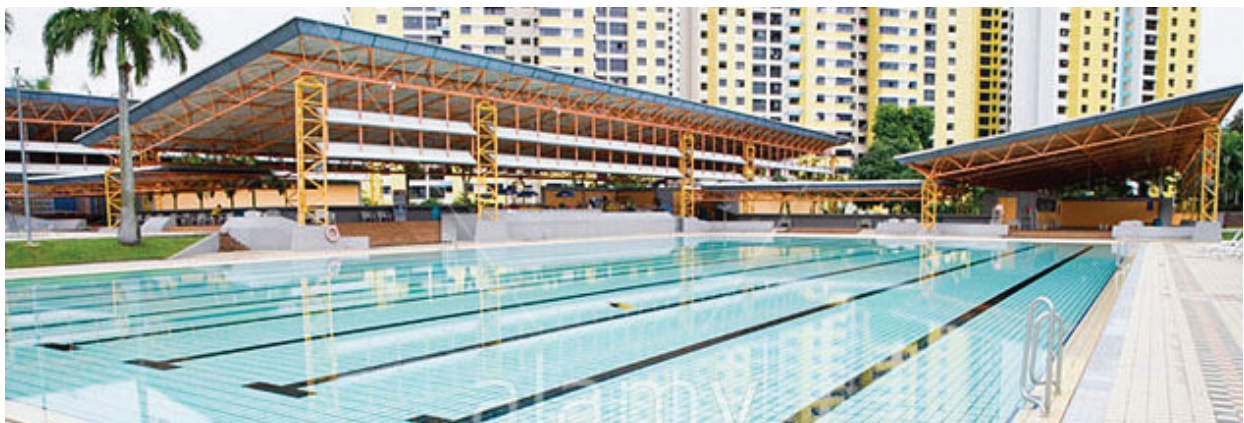

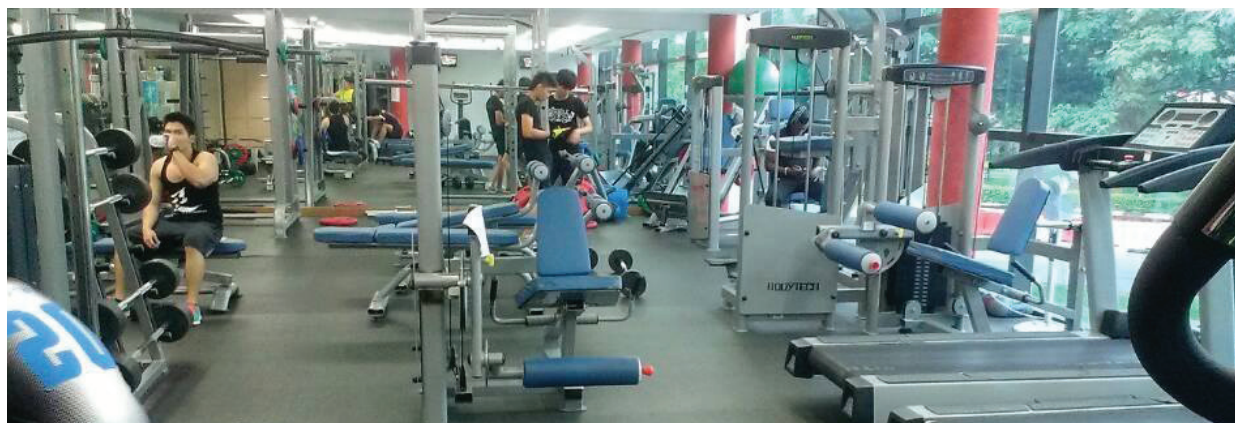

HOUSING

Options for Housing

1. Rent a room in a HDB or condominium
2. Rent a room in a hostel or boarding house
3. Stay with an expat family



Housing Development Board (HDB) Flat

- Ranging from SGD350/sharing to SGD700/single
- Cost effective with common facilities
- Utilities and Internet are usually not included (to check with landlord)
- Agent fee: Usually half-a-month rental for a 1-year lease or less, +7% tax (GST)



Condominium

- Ranging from SGD1000 to SGD1300/month
 - Condos usually come with facilities: Security, swimming pool, gym etc.
- Typical expat living

** Renting an apartment will cost approximately SGD4000 - SGD5000 per apartment (depending on the location, size and condition of the apartment). Apartments situated near MRT stations will cost more.*

LIFE IN SINGAPORE

Singapore

Singapore is a thriving city state in Southeast Asia, with a population of over 5 million, primarily comprising of Chinese, Malay, and Indian ethnic groups. With such a large diversity of ethnic communities, common languages include: English, Malay, Mandarin, Singlish, and Tamil. It is a thriving global financial hub and described as one of Asia's economic "tigers". The currency of Singapore is the Singapore Dollar (SGD).

Singapore also ranks highly on its national social policies, leading Asia and ranked 11th globally, on the Human Development Index (UN), notably on key measures of education, healthcare, life expectancy, quality of life, personal safety and housing. Changi Airport, is one of the largest transportation hubs in Southeast Asia.

Depending on your home country, Singapore may have a multitude of cultural norms and practices that may differ from your own. We recommend reading local websites and blogs to learn more before you arrive.

Exchanging Foreign Currency in Singapore

For your convenience, you can use the foreign currency exchange service at the airport or at the hotel you stay at. But for the best rates, make your way to one of the Singapore's most reputable money changing hubs. They are The Arcade in Raffles Place, Lucky Plaza on Orchard Road, Mustafa Centre in Little India, People's Park Complex in Chinatown, and Parkway Parade in Marine Parade.

Opening a bank account

Before opening an account:

All documents must be ready. They are:

- Passport
- Student Pass / ICA Letter
- Proof of residential address: School's Letter confirming student's name, passport and residential address. Ask your Program Manager for it (kalaivani.aranan@essec.edu)
- Email address
- Singapore Mobile Number

During account opening:

- Go to the account opening link:
<https://www.dbs.com.sg/dbsweb-forms/deposits/apply/cip?product=0058-MA>
- Fill in the information as required
- Scan /take a picture of the documents required
- Submit the application (processing time will take 3 – 5 working days)

After account is opened:

The welcome pack (including the PINs, Debit Card and ibanking token) will be mailed to you.

- Use the debit card number to activate both the account and the debit card

- * There is an early closure fee if your account is closed within 6 months (\$\$30) from when it was opened.
- * Download and utilize the Paylah! App to get rebates.

Traffic

Unlike Europe or the United States, cars are driven on the left side of the road. Do be extra cautious when crossing the road.

Voltage

Singapore voltage is 220-240 volts AC, 50 cycles per second. The power plugs used in Singapore are three-pinned and square-shaped.

Cleanliness in Singapore

Littering is one of Singapore's most common offences committed. First-time offenders who discard minor litter such as sweet wrappers, cigarette butts and parking coupon tabs improperly are liable for a SGD300 fine. First-time littering offenders who throw larger items such as plastic bags, food wrappers and drink cups would be issued a fine which can go up to SGD1,000 or a Community Work Order (CWO) of up to 12 hours, or both.

Eating and drinking on public transport in Singapore is prohibited.

Drinking Water

It is safe to drink water straight from the tap in Singapore. Bottled mineral water are also available at all supermarkets and grocers.

Smoking

Smoking is prohibited in all air-conditioned areas (e.g. shopping centres, restaurants, cinemas, public buses, the MRT, taxis, lifts), common corridors, void decks and staircases within residential buildings, outdoor hospital compounds, as well as a 5-metre radius from any entrance/exit and bus shelter. It is also not allowed on the parks and reservoirs.

Prohibited Items

- Sale of chewing gum (except approved oral dental and medicated gum by HSA)
- Chewing tobacco and imitation tobacco products (e.g. electronic cigarettes, etc)
- Cigarette lighters of pistol or revolver shape
- Controlled drugs and psychotropic substances

(Substance abuse comes with a hefty fine or imprisonment)

- Endangered wildlife species and their by-products
- Firecrackers
- Obscene articles, publications, video tapes/discs and software
- Reproduction of copyright publications

DIRECTIONS TO THE CAMPUS

By Car/Taxi

- From North Buona Vista Road, turn into Portsdown Road.
- Turn into Nepal Park.
- ESSEC Asia-Pacific is located at the end of Nepal Park; you will pass by Unilever Four Acres on your right as you drive in.
- There are limited parking lots at the campus, available on a first-come-first-serve basis.
- You are advised to park at Fusionopolis if parking is not available at the campus.

By MRT

A. Circle Line: One-North Station (CC23)

- Alight at One-North Station and take Exit B (Portsdown Road)
- Cross the road and walk up Nepal Park; ESSEC is located at the end of Nepal Park; you will pass by Unilever Four Acres on your right as you walk in

B. East West Line: Buona Vista Station (EW21/CC22)

- Alight at Buona Vista Station, head towards North Buona Vista Road (Metropolis/Ministry of Education)
- Walk along North Buona Vista Road or take buses 74, 92, 95, 196, 198 or 200 from the bus stop opposite Buona Vista Station (bus stop no. 11369) and alight one stop later opposite Anglo-Chinese JC (bus stop no. 18149)
- The stairs behind the bus stop will lead you to the campus

By Bus

A. From the city

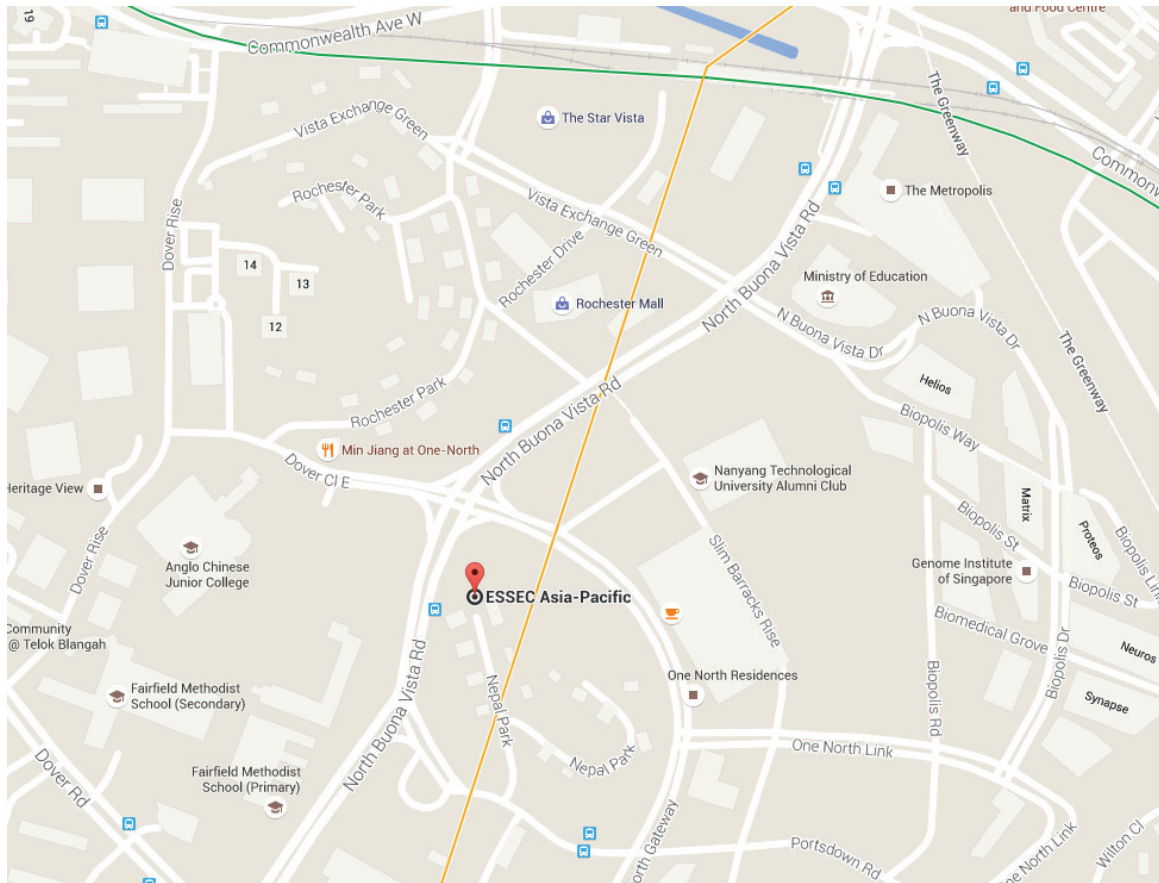
- Alight at the bus stop opposite Anglo-Chinese JC (bus stop no. 18149) along North Buona Vista Road
